



Progress Check – Age 2

The key person will carry out the child's progress check at aged 2 in accordance with any local procedures that are in place.

The progress check aims to review the child's development and ensure the parents have a clear picture of their development.

The key person will note areas where a child is progressing well and identify areas for development.

The progress check will describe the actions that will be taken by setting to the address any development concerns as agreed with the parents.

The key person will plan activities to meet the child's needs within the setting and will support parents to enhance this learning at home.
