



First Aid

At Baldon Village Pre School all staff are qualified to apply first aid treatment in the event of an incident involving a child or adult. At least three first aiders are present in the pre-school, at all times.

Our first aid kit complies with the Health and Safety Regulations 1981 and contains the following items only;

- 4 x Triangular Bandages, One Sterilised.
- 3 x Small Sterile Dressings.
- 3 x Medium HSE1 Sterile Dressings.
- 3 x Large HSE2 Sterile Dressings.
- Composite pack containing 20 assorted plasters, individually wrapped.
- Sterile Eye Pads.
- 6 x Safety Pins.

In addition to the first aid equipment each box should be supplied with;

- 2 x Pairs of Disposable Gloves.
- 1 x Plastic Apron.
- Child's forehead strip thermometer.

The first aid box is easily accessible to adults and is kept out of reach of the children. No un-prescribed medicine is given to parents, adults or staff.

At the time of admission parents give written consent for emergency medical advice or treatment to be sought.

Prescribed medication is stored in each child's box with their care plan.

Parents sign a consent form allowing staff to take their child to the nearest Accident & Emergency Department to be examined, treated or admitted where necessary, on the understanding that parents/carers are to be informed and are on their way to the hospital.
